### **NCFE CACHE Level 2 Certificate in Understanding Autism 601/6330/6**

This qualification is designed for learners who wish to develop an understanding of autism and how to support individuals with autism.

This qualification aims to:

- develop learners' understanding of autism and the principles of supporting individuals with autism - covering the person-centred approach and influence of positive communication methods, how to support positive behaviour and how individuals with autism can be supported to live healthy and fulfilled lives.

The objective of this qualification is to help learners to:

- progress within employment in a variety of sectors, and in a number of job roles where an understanding of autism and knowledge of how to support people with autism is required.

Throughout this qualification, as in the Department of Health Adult Autism Strategy, we've used the term 'autism' as an umbrella term for all autistic spectrum conditions, including Asperger syndrome.

### **NCFE CACHE Level 2 Certificate in Understanding Behaviour that Challenges 603/1062/5**

This qualification is designed to increase learners' awareness and understanding of behaviour that challenges and its effects.

By completing the qualification, learners will develop in-depth knowledge of behaviour that challenges, which could support progression onto other appropriate qualifications and into relevant employment in the health and social care sector. This qualification would be valuable to learners already working in education and health and social care settings.

There are no specific recommended prior learning requirements for this qualification. However, learners may find it helpful if they've already achieved a Level 1 qualification in healthcare, social care, childcare or supporting learning.

### **NCFE CACHE Level 2 Certificate in Understanding Cancer Support 603/5860/9**

The Level 2 Certificate in Understanding Cancer Support is designed for learners who want to increase their knowledge and understanding of supporting adults living with cancer. It could be used as a continuous professional development (CPD) qualification for learners already working within the health care and social care sectors or for individuals providing informal care.

### **NCFE CACHE Level 2 Certificate in Understanding Children and Young People's Mental Health 603/2813/7**

The purpose of this qualification is to increase learner's knowledge and awareness of children and young people's mental health. By completing the qualification, learners will develop knowledge of:

- children and young people's mental health in context
- mental health problems commonly associated with children and young people
- the impact of mental ill-health on children and young people
- support available to maintain mental wellbeing in children and young people.

### **NCFE CACHE Level 2 Certificate in Understanding Common Childhood Illnesses 603/3115/X**

The purpose of this qualification is to increase learners' knowledge and understanding of common childhood illnesses to enable them to support the development and wellbeing of infants and children they support/care for.

### **NCFE Level 2 Certificate in Understanding Data Protection and Data Security (603/3639/0)**

The purpose of this qualification is to allow learners to demonstrate understanding of data protection and data security. It will help learners progress to a work role where data protection and data security knowledge is required.

### **NCFE Level 2 Certificate in Digital Skills for Work**

The purpose of this qualification is to allow learners to demonstrate understanding of and competency in digital literacy skills. It will help learners progress to a work role where digital literacy skills are required.

The objectives of this qualification are to enable learners to:

- understand how to protect devices and data
- communicate socially and professionally using technology
- apply digital skills in personal and business situations
- use digital resources to facilitate own career progression

### **NCFE Level 2 Certificate in Equality and Diversity (601/3145/7)**

This knowledge-based QCF qualification covers enhanced early-stage learning and concepts relating to equality and diversity, particularly relating to society, the workplace, and the community. This will enable learners to develop a level of knowledge beyond the standard employer-sponsored training experience, which will provide them to access to further learning routes or career progression.

The objective of this qualification is to allow learners to:

- raise their awareness of the issues surrounding equality and diversity
- apply this awareness through their actions in society, community and the workplace.

### **NCFE Level 2 Certificate in Understanding Excellence in Customer Service for Hospitality (603/2778/9)**

This qualification is designed for learners who are looking to enter, or progress within, employment in the hospitality sector. It will enable learners to develop knowledge and understanding of customer service excellence for the hospitality sector.

The objectives of this qualification is to enable learners to develop an understanding of:

- communicating with customers in the hospitality sector
- teamwork in the hospitality sector
- professional standards and personal development
- legislation and regulations relating to customer service delivery in the hospitality sector.

### **NCFE CACHE Level 2 Certificate in Understanding Nutrition and Health (601/3389/2)**

This qualification is designed for a wide range of learners with some existing knowledge of this area who are interested in improving their understanding of nutrition and healthy eating. These may be learners who wish to access this training with a view to progress to further qualifications or employment within Sport and Recreation, Exercise and Fitness, Hospitality and Catering or Healthcare. It complements other qualifications and enables learners to develop within their current job role within these sector areas.

### **NCFE Level 2 Certificate in Improving Personal Exercise, Health and Nutrition (603/2831/9)**

This qualification is designed for learners who wish to develop knowledge and understanding of how to improve their own personal exercise, health and nutrition.

The objectives of this qualification are to help learners gain an understanding of:

- the impact of diet, nutrition and exercise on their personal health
- safe and appropriate exercise
- the importance of personal motivation and setting goals and targets.

### **NCFE CACHE Level 2 Certificate in the Principles of the Prevention and Control of Infection in Health Care Settings (600/9312/2)**

The primary purpose of this qualification is to prepare you to either enter or progress within employment in the Health and Social Care sector.

To support you, this qualification aims to help you understand:

- the meaning and importance of infection control
- the causes of infections, the conditions in which they thrive, and the ways that they can be spread
- the methods used to prevent and control the spread of infection.

This objective of this qualification is to help you to:

- gain knowledge and understanding of infection prevention and control, to support your role in a Health or Social Care workplace
- progress onto further learning in this area or within the wider area of Health and Social Care.

### **NCFE CACHE Level 2 Certificate in Information, Advice or Guidance (601/4321/6)**

The qualification has mandatory units and a number of optional units to allow you to follow subject areas to meet your own requirements. This qualification is suitable for you if you are working in a role or progressing to a role where you will give introductory information, advice or guidance to others and have no formal qualifications in this area.

### **Level 2 Certificate in LGBT Inclusion in the Workplace (RQF) 603/5261/9**

This qualification has been developed for learners who need to be more aware of how to comfortably interact with lesbian, gay, bisexual and trans (LGBT) people in the workplace.

It has been designed to make learners aware of the LGBT history and culture and the organisational policies and legislation affecting LGBT people in the workplace. It also explores the impact of language, stereotyping and assumptions relating to LGBT people and considers how learners can best contribute to maintaining a supportive workplace environment for LGBT people.

The range of units contained in this qualification enable the learner to gain an understanding of the history and culture of the LGBT movement, the importance of using appropriate language, not stereotyping nor making assumptions about LGBT people. It also enables the learner to know about the organisation policies and legislation which promotes the rights of LGBT people in the workplace and to identify and challenge inappropriate homophobic and biphobic behaviour in the workplace. This qualification could also prove invaluable toward the learner's personal and career development.

### **QRN: 603/5148/2 NCFE CACHE Level 2 Certificate in Understanding Mental Health First Aid and Mental Health Advocacy in the Workplace**

This qualification is suitable for learners who wish to raise awareness of mental health, creating a culture of care and the promotion of positive mental health. This qualification gives learners the opportunity to understand mental health, its associated care and how this can be applied to learners or colleagues in the workplace.

### **Level 1 Award in Ways to Maintain Personal Well-being (RQF)**

This qualification has been developed for the widest range of learners possible: young people, students and adults, those who are entering further or higher education or pre-employment, recently unemployed or between jobs. It has been designed to make learners aware of the principles of personal well-being and some of the ways of maintaining it. It also explores the impact of positive behaviour, healthy-eating, mindfulness and meditation on mental well-being.

### **NCFE CACHE Level 2 Certificate in Understanding Safeguarding and Prevent 603/2818/6**

The purpose of this qualification is to increase the learner's knowledge and awareness of the Prevent Duty and safeguarding, including online safety. By completing the qualification, learners will develop knowledge of safeguarding in an environment where they have a duty of care.

### **TQUK Level 2 Certificate in Self-harm and Suicide Awareness and Prevention**

This qualification has been designed to examine all areas surrounding these sensitive topics. Learners will discover how to recognise the signs of self-harm and suicidal thoughts, as well as how to approach an individual they believe is experiencing this. They will look at managing and minimising self-harm risk, and finally, how to support individuals dealing with grief after suicide.

### **NCFE CACHE Level 2 Certificate in Understanding Specific Learning Difficulties 603/2041/2**

The purpose of this qualification is to equip learners with the knowledge of different Specific Learning Difficulties, how they are diagnosed and how individuals can be supported. The qualification can be used by a wide range of learners looking to improve their knowledge and awareness in this subject area, including those working within healthcare, social care and education contexts. The qualification is also suitable for teaching staff, care staff or anyone looking to build their knowledge of dyslexia and other learning difficulties.

### **NCFE CACHE Level 2 Certificate in Understanding the Care and Management of Diabetes (600/9311/0)**

This qualification will help you get into, or progress within, employment in the healthcare or social care sectors in a variety of job roles where an understanding of the care and management of diabetes is required. You can also take this qualification to support your progression into further learning within the Health and Social Care sector.

To support you in this the qualification aims to:

- provide you with an understanding of the different types of diabetes and how they can occur
- develop your awareness of how the onset of Type 2 diabetes can be delayed with lifestyle changes
- develop your understanding of diabetes diagnosis and initial care
- develop your understanding of on-going care and treatment of diabetes to control blood sugar levels.

The objectives of this qualification will help you to:

- gain knowledge and understanding of diabetes to support your role in a healthcare or social care workplace
- progress to further learning in this subject area or within the wider area of Health and Social Care.

### **NCFE CACHE Level 2 Certificate in Understanding the Safe Handling of Medication in Health and Social Care**

This knowledge-only qualification is designed for learners wishing to develop their understanding of the safe handling of medication.

It provides the knowledge and understanding of:

- different types of medication and their use
- the procedures for obtaining, storing, administering and disposing of medication
- legislation and the audit process related to medication and issues of responsibility and accountability
- the record keeping process for medication.
