

Social Media issue

Dear Parents and Carers,

We are writing to make you aware of a serious concern that has been brought to the attention of the school regarding an online social media group titled “**ADD MORE PEOPLE UNTIL WE GET TO THE MAX.**” A parent notified us that this group is currently circulating inappropriate, sexualised, and racially offensive content.

At this time, it appears that the group includes approximately 950 members, with students from across College, Oakfield, and Selwood reportedly having access or being invited to join.

Please be reassured that the safeguarding and leadership teams across our schools are working together to address the situation.

We ask for your support by:

1. **Checking your child’s devices and social media accounts** to confirm whether they have been added to or are participating in this group.
2. **Discussing with them** the importance of reporting harmful content and leaving any groups that share inappropriate or abusive material.
3. **Ensuring privacy settings** on their devices and apps are set to the highest protection levels.
4. **Contacting the school** if you discover your child is involved or if you need support in managing their online activity.

Please remind your child that sharing or engaging with sexual or racist material online can have serious safeguarding, wellbeing, and legal consequences.

If you have any concerns or require further guidance, please do not hesitate to contact your child’s school’s safeguarding team. We appreciate your cooperation as we work together to ensure the safety and wellbeing of all our students.
