Dear Parents,

Please find two sections of information in this letter. One for pupils who will be learning in school and one for those who will be learning from home.

Learning in School

Please see below the arrangements for your child if they are learning in school from Wednesday 6th January.

Uniform

Pupils are expected to wear school uniform as they did before the Christmas holidays. They need to wear their PE kit on the days they do PE.

Timings of the school day

These will remain the same:

KS2 – Pupils to arrive between 8.25 and 8.35 (Y5 – RED GATE, Y6 – SILVER GATE) Pupils leave at 3pm

KS3 – Pupils to arrive between 8.35 and 8.45 (Y7 – RED GATE, Y8 – SILVER GATE) Pupils leave at 3.10

Breakfast Club

Breakfast club will be running as usual, if you are interested in a place please either complete a form from our website or contact our academy office by email.

Transport

Somerset Bus service will still be running as normal. Please remember that face coverings must be worn throughout bus journeys.

Lunch

Please provide your child with a packed lunch for this week, we are working with our canteen to establish whether they will be able to provide their usual lunches. If your child is eligible for a free school meal they will be provided with a packed lunch.

Face Coverings

You must provide your child with a face covering to wear on site, pupils will be asked to put these on before they leave the classroom to help keep everyone safe. Some pupils have found it easier to use a 'neck warmer' that can be pulled up over the mouth and nose when required.

Equipment

We ask pupils to bring in a rucksack with their water bottle, lunch and pencil case in, as they did before the Christmas holidays.

Years 5 and 6 and FLG

Years 7 and 8

Your child needs to ensure that they have joined all their different classrooms using the codes provided by their teacher. Pupils will be set work as per the lessons on their timetable in their journal. It will be on ParentApp for Year 7 and 8 parents. Please ask your child to check their **oakfieldacademy.org gmail address** as these codes have been emailed to them, as well as a short video guide about how to show ambition and take pride in their remote learning.
