The cost of the trip is £30.00 which covers all the activities and coach travel to and from the site. It is the responsibility of parents to ensure their child's safe return home at that time.

Please note that if the behaviour of your child falls below the expectations we have at Oakfield Academy, we will have to consider whether we believe it is safe to take them. We will consider the rights of everyone to enjoy their activity day. This will be the perfect opportunity for our pupils to put in to practice their team-building skills and challenge themselves to try new things together.

#### Pupils should come to school wearing suitable clothing and footwear:

Waterproof coat, comfortable walking shoes/trainers, clothing would be better in layers – old clothes due to possible mud (plus change of clothing/footwear and a towel). Pupils will also need a large plastic bag for any damp or dirty clothes, a refillable water bottle, snacks for breaktime, a lunch box with a packed lunch, and possibly suncream and a hat. Jeans cannot be worn as per guidance from the Centre. We also ask that no electrical equipment be brought and phones (if essential) must be handed to staff.
