

## How to get the best from MyMaths!

MyMaths is a UK based online learning platform for schools worldwide. It provides access to a carefully structured range of ready-made lessons and online homework tasks, which support Oakfield's core maths curriculum. It is particularly useful during lockdown because:

- MyMaths marks your work as you go along so you know how well you are doing.
- MyMaths stores your work so your teacher will be able to see what you have achieved...and if you need some help!
- You can work at your own speed, choose your own level of challenge and develop great independent learning habits.

Here is a quick guide on how to make the most of MyMaths, whether you are a beginner (or haven't used it for a while) or a more experienced user.

<ul> <li>Website is Mymaths.co.uk.</li> <li>School username is oakfield, school password is equal6.</li> <li>Once you are in, you can see all the available tasks (covering KS1 to A-level!). You should then go to "My portal" with your own login details to see tasks specifically set for you.</li> <li>If there are several tasks, choose the ones that link in with the Little Lessons you are doingor tasks that will remind you of previous learning. If you are confident, go straight for the "homework" task. If not, check out the attached lesson first, then try the task. Go through the lesson carefully.</li> </ul>	<ul> <li>If you complete a task and do not get a "green" result, go back and look carefully at the attached lesson and then redo the homework. If you are still having difficulties, either choose an easier task, or contact your maths teacher via <u>maths@oakfieldacademy.org</u> for guidance.</li> <li>Each task has a level assigned to it. Use these to help decide which tasks to attempt. The higher the level, the more challenging the task. If you are finding tasks too easy, pick a higher level taskand vice versa.</li> <li>If you can't find a MyMaths task for the area of maths you are studying, use the search facility, or contact your teacher as above.</li> </ul>
