Application/permission slips can be completed on ParentPay, by selecting 'Pay for other items' and clicking on the name of the club to go to the consent section. In accordance with our Safeguarding Policy, please ensure club leaders are informed, if for any reason your child is unable to attend a club or moves to another club. If you are able to book a club then your child has a place, if not unfortunately the club is full. New clubs start regularly, please check out our Website, Newsletter and Facebook Page for information. If for any reason a club has to be cancelled, we would expect KS3 pupils to make their own way home. Pupils in KS2 can wait in the hall if they cannot make their own way home. Please talk to your child about what they should do, if this ever happens.

IMPORTANT ANNOUNCEMENT

On Wednesday the UK Health Security Agency announced that from 11 January asymptomatic people in England who test positive for coronavirus (COVID-19) on a lateral flow device (LFD) test no longer need to get a confirmatory PCR test. Their isolation period can start immediately following their positive LFD test result. These individuals should still report their test results on <u>GOV.UK</u>.

This is a temporary measure while coronavirus rates remain high across the UK. Whilst levels of coronavirus are high, the government has said that the vast majority of people with positive LFD test results can be confident that they have coronavirus

LFD tests should only be taken by people who do not have coronavirus symptoms.

Anyone who develops has symptoms should self-isolate and take a PCR test. They must self-isolate if they get a positive test result, even if they have had a recent negative LFD test – these rules have not changed.

Clarification on the changes to the self-isolation period for individuals who test positive for COVID-19

Since Wednesday 22 December, the 10 day self-isolation period for people who record a positive PCR test result for COVID-19 has been reduced to 7 days in most circumstances, unless you cannot test for any reason.

Individuals may now take LFD tests on day 6 and day 7 of their self-isolation period. Those who receive two negative test results are no longer required to complete 10 full days of self-isolation. The first test must be taken no earlier than day 6 of the self-isolation period and tests must be taken 24 hours apart. This also applies to children under 5, with LFD testing at parental. If both these test results are negative, and you do not have a high temperature, you may end your self-isolation after the second negative test result and return to your education or childcare setting from day 7.

Anyone who is unable to take LFD tests will need to complete the full 10 day period of self-isolation. Further information, including examples of when to end self-isolation if you have had COVID-19 symptoms, is available in the <u>stay at home: guidance for households with possible or confirmed COVID-19</u> <u>infection</u>.
