### APPLICATION AND TRANSFER UPDATE

The online portal for applications for children to start secondary school in September 2023, or transfer to Upper school, is now OPEN. The closing date is 31 October 2022.

PLEASE NOTE FOR CHILDREN WHO ARE DUE TO START SCHOOL IN RECEPTION IN SEPTEMBER 2023 OR TRANSFER TO JUNIOR OR MIDDLE SCHOOL IN SEPTEMBER 2023, THE ON LINE PORTAL WILL BE OPEN ON 26TH SEPTEMBER 2022.

#### A few tips before you start;

- If you previously applied for a child starting or transferring school in 2017 or earlier you will need to re-register on the portal as a new system was introduced at this time.
- If you do not receive your registration or forgotten password email please check your junk mail. If you still do not received an email please contact schooladmissions@somerset.gov.uk
- We do not use Unique Identification Numbers (UID) in Somerset so if prompted, just click 'NO UID'.
  As with any IT system there is always the potential for unforeseen issues so if you experience any problems, please let us know and we'll look into it as quickly as we can.
