



#### **CROSS COUNTRY CUP REPORT**

On a very sunny Wednesday 13<sup>th</sup> October, 10 brave Oakfield pupils participated in the first round of the ESAA (English Schools' Athletics Association) Cross Country Cup at Downside School, Radstock.

The Junior Girl's race was hotly contested and consisted of 2km of open fields, banks, and wooded areas. Caitlin Markey stormed around the course to finish in a fantastic 14<sup>th</sup> place, with Scarlett Parker close behind in 31<sup>st</sup> position. Sophia Giorgetti-Knott, Georgina Hutchinson, Freya Walters, and Daisy Hartland followed on in excellent placings with 45<sup>th</sup>, 44<sup>th</sup>, 46<sup>th</sup>, and 51<sup>st</sup> respectively.

The Junior Boy's race was next with Max Barraclough, Jacob Hillier, Archie Pearce, and Danny Simpson. After a rapid start, the 4 Oakfield pupils were well settled into their races and all finished strong after the furious 2.8km race! Archie finished in 31<sup>st</sup>, Jacob- 47<sup>th</sup>, Danny in 58<sup>th</sup>, and Max in 61<sup>st</sup> position.
