The Friends have recently bought some wonderful new phonics reading books for the library to support our pupils on the *Fresh Start* programme! Photos to follow!




On Thursday and Friday this week 12 of our pupils completed a 2-day Bikeability Training Course with Instructors from The Bikeability Trust.

### **SCIENCE NEWS**

On Tuesday Oakfield's Year 7 STEM GoIT proudly represented the UK in the Europe, Middle East and Africa Geographic area of the Global Young Innovator of the Year 2025. Their ride share app idea, Somershare, was selected from over <u>80,000</u> student entries from across the globe during 2024, submitted to Tata Consultancy Services (tcs) GoIT as part of their empowers STEM programme. There were 9 other schools competing including schools from as close by as



Manchester, to as far afield as Cape Town, South Africa. The team were praised by the judges for their polished presentation (despite some technical microphone issues!) and their innovative rideshare solution.

Unfortunately, we now need to wait until the 7th April until we find out if they have won after final judging is completed in the other geographies. Watch this space as we eagerly find out. Regardless of the outcome, the UK coordinator has passed on the message below to the team:-

"Not only have they made their schools incredibly proud, but they've also done an exceptional job representing the UK at the goIT Global Finals. I wish them the best of luck in the final judging! Regardless of the outcome, please know that all of your students are already winners in our eyes."
