



### Safer School Streets survey is live

Frome Town Council (FTC) is inviting you to share your thoughts on Frome's Safer School Streets trial via an online survey and an engagement event on Wednesday 14th May at Oakfield Academy from 5pm to 6.30pm. Qualitative and quantitative data collected during the trial will be available to view and representatives of project partners Frome Town Council, Somerset Council and active travel charity Sustrans will be on hand to speak to people about Frome's Safer School Streets scheme. We'll also be 'popping up' around the zones in the coming weeks, offering further opportunities to connect.

This questionnaire is an opportunity for school parents, guardians and staff to share experiences of the scheme at the 12-month stage of the 18-month trial period. Your feedback will help us understand how the scheme is working and inform any future decisions.


