Swimming Lessons Intensive swimming lessons are an excellent introduction to regular lessons or to enable children already in lessons to work on their skills and strokes to help them progress faster in their weekly class. This summer we are also offering Starts and Turns (diving in at start of a swim and tumble turns for Front Crawl/Backstroke and legal turns for Breaststroke and Butterfly). We have separate technique clinics for butterfly and Breaststroke - perfect if you need help to master 1 of these strokes. We will also be giving your child the opportunity to earn some distance badges over 25metres (distance awards will include a badge and certificate).
