We are pleased to report the SATs results for this academic year: Reading: 63% (down from 70%) Maths: 55% (up from 50%) Combined: 47% (up from 42%) GPS: 57% (down from 62%)

We must take into account the cohort is smaller this year—these results show the journey we are on with increases in both Maths and the combined scores again this year.

A big well done to all the teachers who have worked tirelessly to support our pupils, and of course to the pupils who have worked so hard.
