- The 999 Cenotaph will stand for 1,000 years on Whitehall, London. It will be 21ft tall.
- The design includes 6 figures representing the different emergency services, plus a dog
- The 999 Cenotaph is proudly supported by HRH Prince William, Duke of Cambridge
