

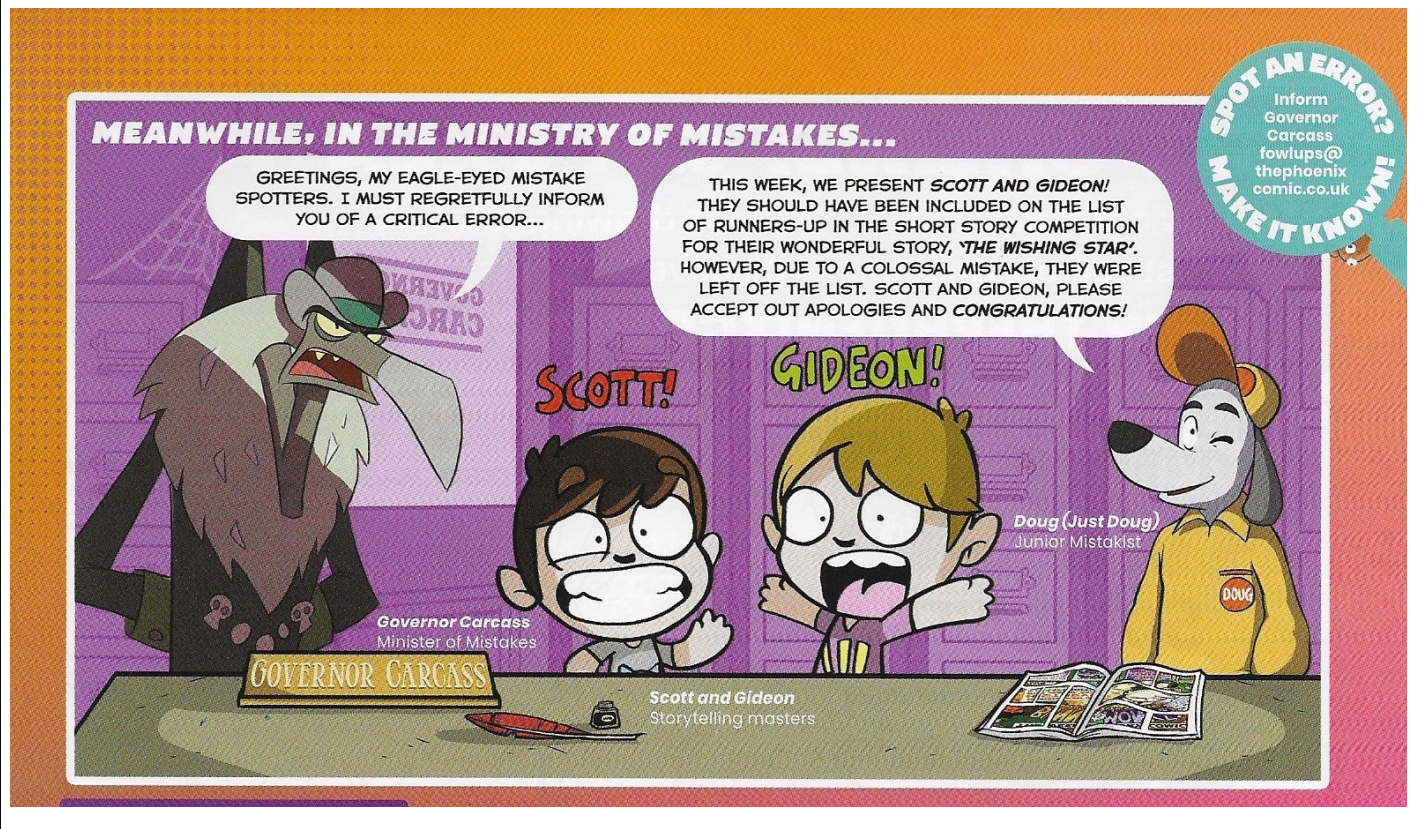

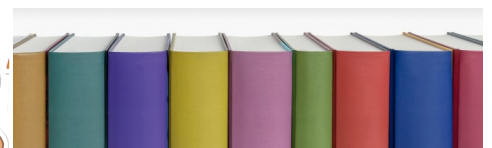

Julian Hight is a local ancient tree specialist and shares his amazing knowledge about the trees and the biodiversity that they support.


