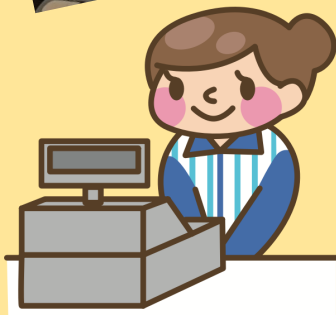


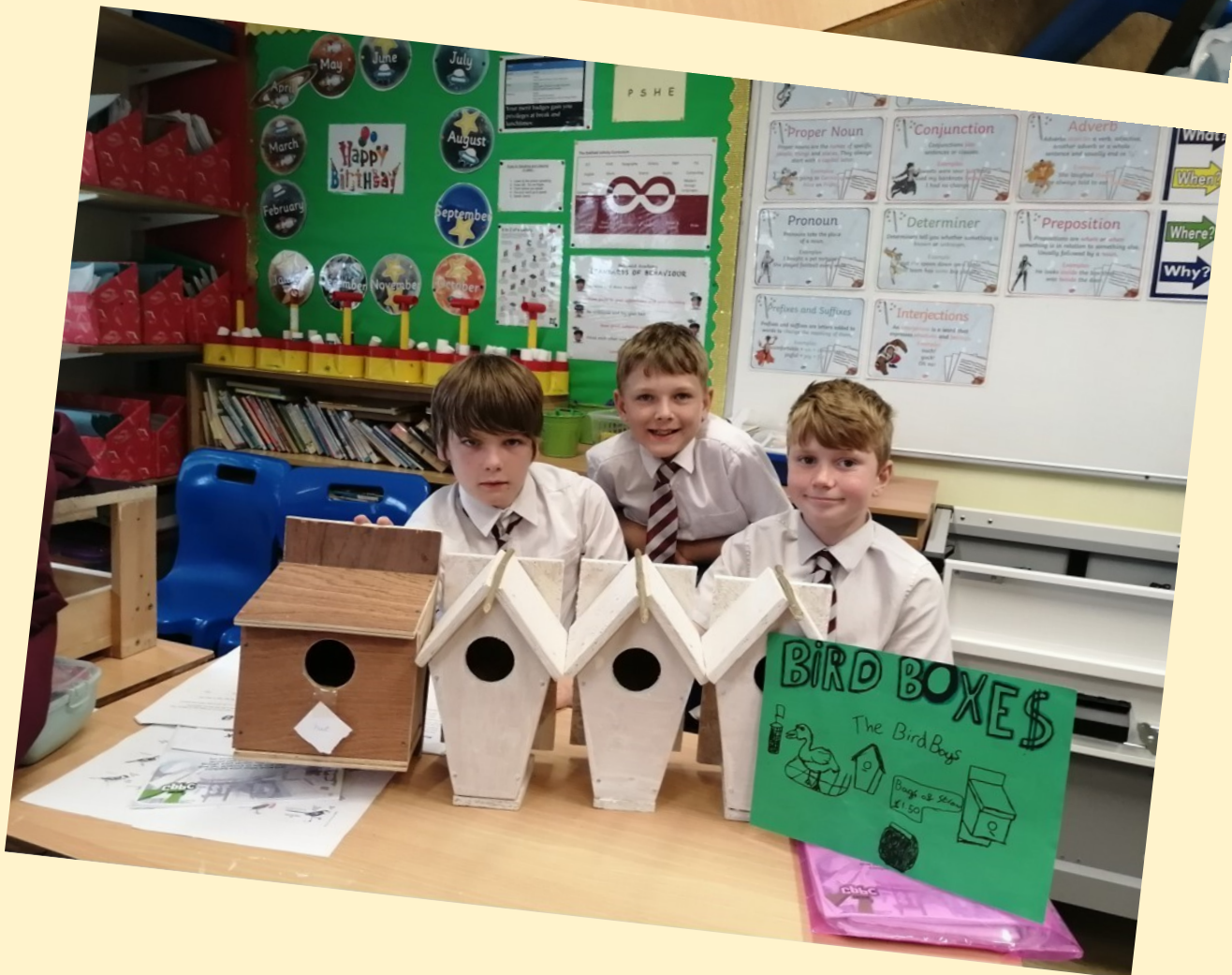
Yr 6 enjoy Enterprise Week
