Congratulations to Isla Neilson who was presented with our termly Citizenship Award at the end of last term by Mr Bowker our Deputy Headteacher.


# Frome International Climate Film Festival 2024 19th May at the Cheese and Grain


We are planning to hold a second hand uniform sale after the Easter Holidays (date tbc).


