Profits will be divided between Year 5 Activities and DOGS FOR HEALTH.



Please encourage pupils to arrive on time (8.25am) as good attendance = good progress.




Oakfield Academy celebrates effort and ambition in art. This week's artwork was produced in art lessons, at home and at our Specialist Art club:
