Dear Parent,

Thank you for your patience while we have been studying all the guidance and considering what steps we can take to safely start to expand our provision. Whilst risk assessment documents are being completed here, I will outline a summary of what our priorities are and what being in school will look like, so that you can complete the survey.

Our priority for providing places will continue to be:

1. Our most vulnerable pupils from all year groups
2. The children of key workers from all year groups

These groups are rapidly growing in numbers and so our expanded provision for w/b Monday 1st June will only include this larger group in their new rooms and arrangements. Staff will also be in school receiving training; preparing rooms and resources; scheduling staggered activities; checking the environment and designing the curriculum offer.

3. From Monday 8th June we will be able to consider the Year 6 pupils requesting to return and what capacity there is within tutor groups.
4. Our next priority will be to arrange time in school for our Year 8 pupils to properly finish their time at Oakfield and prepare for transition.
5. Finally, we will be looking to see if we can arrange for pupils in Years 5 and 7 to spend time with their tutors.

Academy arrangements:

- Pupils attending will be in small classes (the average is 8 in our rooms) and they will stay in their tutor room with 1 teacher (their tutor where this is possible) all day
- Break times will be staggered but pupils from different tutor groups will not be allowed to play together
- Lunch will need to be a packed lunch and pupils will need to bring their own water bottle
- There is no requirement for PPE provision in schools except for use within our emergency isolation room
- We will continue regular hygiene – hand washing and hand sanitisation between each activity. Social distancing will be aimed for but cannot be guaranteed at all times! We will continue our 'Catch it, Bin it, Kill it!' approach
- Uniform does not need to be worn. There needs to be a complete change of clothes from one day in school to the next
- Deep cleaning rotas are established with twice daily routines in place
