POLICEMAN. OK, why were you in the garden in the first place?

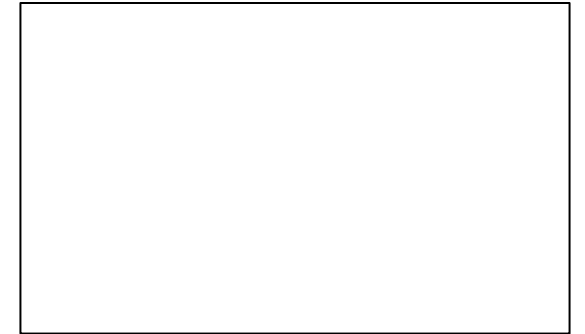
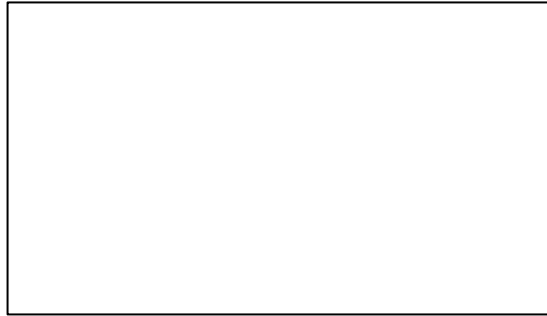
CHRISTOPHER. I was holding the dog.
