The Design Technology and History departments are planning a visit to Brunel's SS Great Britain in The Great Western Dockyard, Bristol on Thursday 26<sup>th</sup> March for Year 8 pupils.

The visit will include transport to and from Bristol, a guided tour of the ship, an interactive workshop, a break for a packed lunch followed by time to explore the museum. The cost of this trip is **£18.00**, which can be paid using our paperless system Parentpay. Please select 'Pay for other items' and SS GTB will take you to the appropriate consent and payment section. Pupils need to wear school uniform and appropriate outdoor clothing. They will need a packed lunch/drink, please let us know if your child is entitled to a FSM and if they would like the school to provide them with a lunch.

We have 90 pupil places available for this trip, which will be allocated on a first come first served basis. We will leave school at 8.30am, and will return to school at around 3.30pm. Parents are responsible for their child's safe return home once we arrive back at Oakfield. Deadline for applications (if the trip is not already full) is 6<sup>th</sup> March 2020.
