We would like to invite you to join us for Sports Day this year. Information for your child's Sports Day is included below. We hope that you can join us to celebrate the culmination of a fantastic year of sport at Oakfield Academy. If you are able to attend, then please enter the Academy through the red side gates where you will be directed to the field. Please feel free to bring a picnic blanket to sit on for your comfort, and hats/umbrellas as there is no shade.

KS2 Sports Day – 15th July (Year 5 – 1-2pm, Year 6 – 2-3pm)

We have decided that this year we would run a sports day for KS2 that is fully inclusive, so that all pupils can participate and have fun. Parents please arrive at **1pm for Year 5** and **2pm for Year 6**, through the red gates, to allow adequate space for the activities that pupils will take part in this afternoon, which are:

- Hoop race
- Egg & Spoon race
- Beanbag race
- Skipping race
- Sack race
- Obstacle race

The red gates will be locked in between arrivals and departures. A reminder that it is also a Multi-day. Pupils will therefore need to remember PE kits and will be changing into them during their lunch time, or they can wear PE kit for this MUFTI.

KS3 Sports Day – 18th July (Year 7 & 8, 2-3pm)

You are invited to the finale, which begins at 2.00pm and will include the **100m & 200m** sprints, **800m** and the **relay** event. Sports Day will conclude at 3pm. If you would like to attend then **please arrive at Oakfield Academy for 1:55pm through the red gates** to allow time to be seated before the events begin. To avoid disappointment, please note that only pupils who have qualified through the morning heats will be taking part in the finale. Unfortunately we are unable to communicate if your child has qualified on the day.

Should the weather forecast be poor, we will have made a decision by 11am on the day and will inform you of the cancellation by Parentpay & the Academy website. Should sports day be cancelled, normal lessons will resume.
