I am delighted to announce that we have organised trips for Year 5 pupils to visit Stonehenge and the new English Heritage visitor centre. The first trip is on Tuesday 17th October 2023, for pupils in 5S and 5O.

We will leave school at 10.30am, returning at 4.40pm and will be travelling to and from the site by coach. Pupils should wear school uniform, trainers and take suitable waterproof outdoor clothing for the time of year. Pupils will need to bring with them a packed lunch and a drink, pupils who usually receive a free school meal can have a packed lunch provided by the academy (please indicate if you would like this provided when you give consent). We will return to school before the end of the school day, so normal after school arrangements for clubs or travelling home will apply.
