I am delighted to announce that we have organised trips for Year 5 pupils to visit Stonehenge and the new English Heritage visitor centre. The second trip is on Wednesday 7th February 2024, for pupils in 5A and 5R.

We will leave school at 9.00am, returning at 2.50pm and will be travelling to and from the site by coach. Pupils should wear school uniform, trainers and take suitable waterproof outdoor clothing for the time of year.
