Dear Parents,

On Wednesday 2nd July your child will have the opportunity to spend the day in their new tutor group with their peers and tutor.

Due to financial pressures we will be reducing the number of classes across the school. In years 6, 7 and 8 there will be 5 classes. To make sure we have an even spread of boys and girls, Special Educational Needs and abilities we are looking to mix up the classes more than usual. The children's friendships have been taken into account and hope the pupils settle in quickly and smoothly. If there are concerns about the groupings, please contact the Head of Year, however we will be expecting pupils to give their new groups a go for at least a half term before any changes are considered.

You will notice that the names of the tutor groups have changed. The tutor group name will be the year group followed by the teacher's initials.

We are reducing the number of houses in the school. We will have 4 houses (yet to be named) and the pupils will be placed in the houses ready for September - families will be placed in the same House.

Another change is for Year 8's who have opted to choose a language, either Spanish or French. Mr Wagstaff has looked at the lists carefully and taken on board pupil requests and tried where possible to match this.

Further information will be shared with you by your child's Head of Year in the next couple of days about what the next academic year holds.
