Following recent advice from the Government and Public Health England regarding the COVID-19 outbreak, I am writing to update you on our position.

Governmental advice is now published as:

If you or anyone in your household have symptoms of coronavirus, then all household members must stay at home and not leave the house for **14 days**. The 14-day period starts from the day when the first person in the house became ill.
