Dear Parents,

I am pleased to inform you of an exciting trip we have organised for our Year 6 pupils. We have a full day of activities planned at Thoulstone Park, Chapmanslade. The activities booked are:-

Climbing Wall Archery Team Challenge

Pioneering Axe throwing Zip Wire

All activities will be run by staff employed at Wiltshire Outdoor Learning Team.

The dates for the trips are: Wednesday 9th and Thursday 10th July 2025

(dates/class allocation are dependent upon numbers)

The cost of the trip is £56.20 which covers all the activities and coach travel to Thoulstone Park, Chapmanslade. A deposit of £25.00 is required by Friday 28th March. The balance of £31.20 can be paid by Tuesday 29th April. Please email the office if your child has requirements that we should be aware of in relation to these activities. We shall be leaving Oakfield at 8.15am – **pupils to arrive at 8.00am**, and we shall be returning at 3.45pm. It is the responsibility of parents to ensure their child's safe return home at that time.

If your child usually receives a free school meal, please can you confirm that you wish us to provide a packed lunch, or will you provide lunch for them. All pupils will require sufficient drinks for the day.

Please note that if the behaviour of your child falls below the expectations we have at Oakfield Academy, we will have to consider whether we believe it is safe to take them. We will consider the rights of everyone to enjoy their activity day. This will be the perfect opportunity for our pupils to put into practice team-building skills and challenge themselves to try new things together. They will develop our core concepts of Ambition, Etiquette, Honesty, Respect, Kindness and Pride.

Pupils should come to school wearing suitable clothing and footwear:
