Dear Parent

As you are aware your child will be transitioning into Year 6 and this is an opportune time to give you information about the changes they will experience.

Your child's tutor will be _____ in 6 .

In Year 6 your child will eat their lunch slightly later at 12.40pm as they will have their free time to play before this at 12.15pm.

The curriculum strategy is largely the same as in Year 5. The biggest difference will be your child taking the SATs tests during the second week in May. Your child will be prepared for these assessments by their Literacy and Maths teachers. The Literacy tests will include assessments in Reading comprehension, Spelling, Punctuation and Grammar. The Maths tests include a mental arithmetic paper followed by two separate papers that test for Reasoning and Understanding of Mathematical concepts.

In the summer term our school PCSO comes to talk to the children about crime and consequences as they are now all over the age of 10 and so at the age of criminal responsibility. He talks through scenarios about what happens if they do things wrong, how they will be dealt with and what the further consequences may be.

The summer term is also the time when we hold out talk about periods. This is done separately to the boys and girls. Resources will be available for parents nearer the time.
