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| Year 5 | In KS2 (Years 5 and 6) we follow a yearly plan that is broken down into three terms. The coverage of this is designed to fit around our school terms, and assessments take place at appropriate times to allow us to analyse the progress made by each student. This is designed as a 2 year preparation for the SATs in Year 6, and covers all the objectives of the National Curriculum for both years 5 and 6. |

| Year 7 | In KS3 we follow a 2 year plan that has been specifically designed to cover the new (2014) KS3 curriculum. We have taken each of the National Curriculum objectives and arranged them into 11 teaching blocks that are covered between the beginning of year 7 and the assessment point at the end of year 8. There is an assessment point towards the end of year 7, and we now also assess each block separately to help identify where students have made progress, and identify areas for further development. |
