Dear Parents,

Welcome back to the new school year, I hope that your child is settling into this new year at Oakfield Academy. The Modern Languages Department is planning a trip to Spain for our Year 8 students in March 2020. Here at Oakfield Academy we place great value on the importance of learning about other cultures and this trip allows students to do so in a safe, fun and controlled environment. It is a fantastic learning experience which has always been extremely popular. Students come back with new friends, new experiences and an opportunity to enable already keen linguists to further their knowledge of the subject. We will be staying in a hotel in Cadiz and will have use of a private coach for the duration of the trip. As well as a tour of Cadiz there will be many other visits:

Cadiz	Panoramic tour, Torre Tavira, Barrio del Populo, Castles of Santa Catalina and San Sebastian and Caleta Beach
Sanlucar de Barrameda	The nature park of Las Mariasmas de Doñana, a cruise on the Guadalquivir river (including lunch in typical restaurant)
Jerez de la Frontera	The cradle of flamenco and some free time in a supermarket and visit a wine cellar.
Sevilla	Panoramic tour, real alcazar, plus lunch in a typical restaurant, and cathedral visit in Giralda.

The cost of this trip will be approximately £590.00 which includes:-

- **Flights**
- **Accommodation in a 4* hotel**
- **Coach transport in Spain**
- **Airport transfers between Frome and Bristol**
- **All meals**
- **Excursions and insurance for 5 days**

The trip will take place from Monday 2nd March – Friday 6th March 2020. More detailed information will be provided in due course. All students will need their own Passport and European Health Insurance Card (free online). Due to this trip potentially taking place after Brexit, we will update you with changes required.

Pupils who are applying for a place on this trip will be notified if they have been successful no later than Monday 21st October 2019 and a non refundable deposit of £200.00 will have to be paid by 28th October 2019 to enable the travel agent to buy the flights and pay the deposit for the hotel. Priority will be given to Year 8 pupils currently studying Spanish, however pupils studying French can also apply.
