Our learning for the term

Supporting your child at home

Reading

Phonics

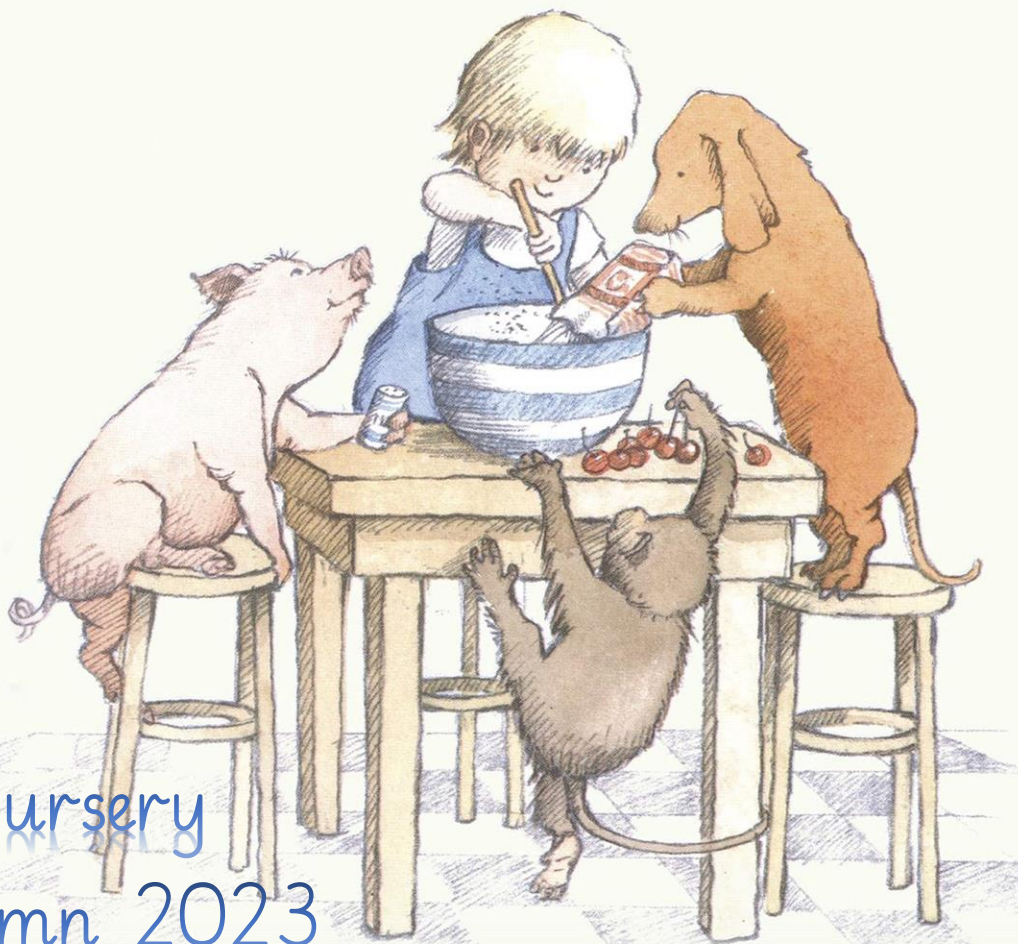
Science
