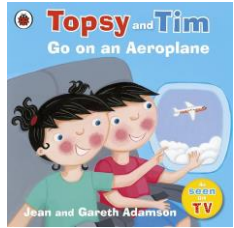
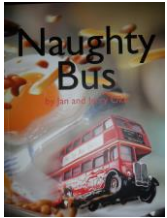
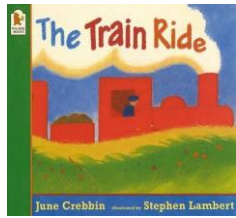


Welcome back! I hope you have had a lovely break. We have lots of fun learning planned for Summer Term!

Know that there are different countries in the world and discuss their differences.

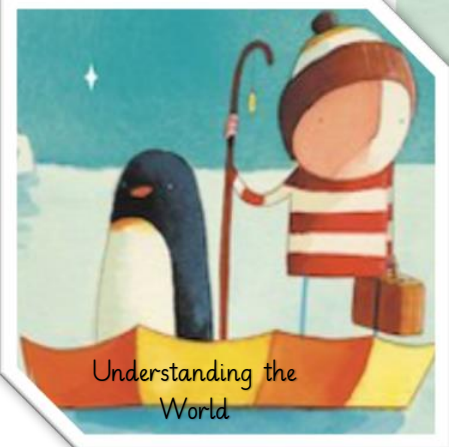
