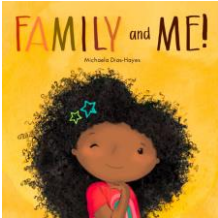
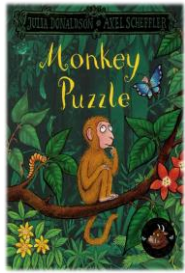
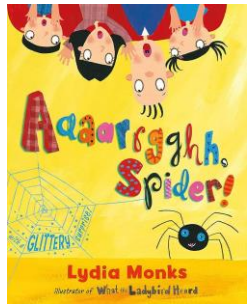


Welcome to Reception with Miss Vincent, Miss Fletcher and Mrs Anthony.

Supporting your child at home

Write captions

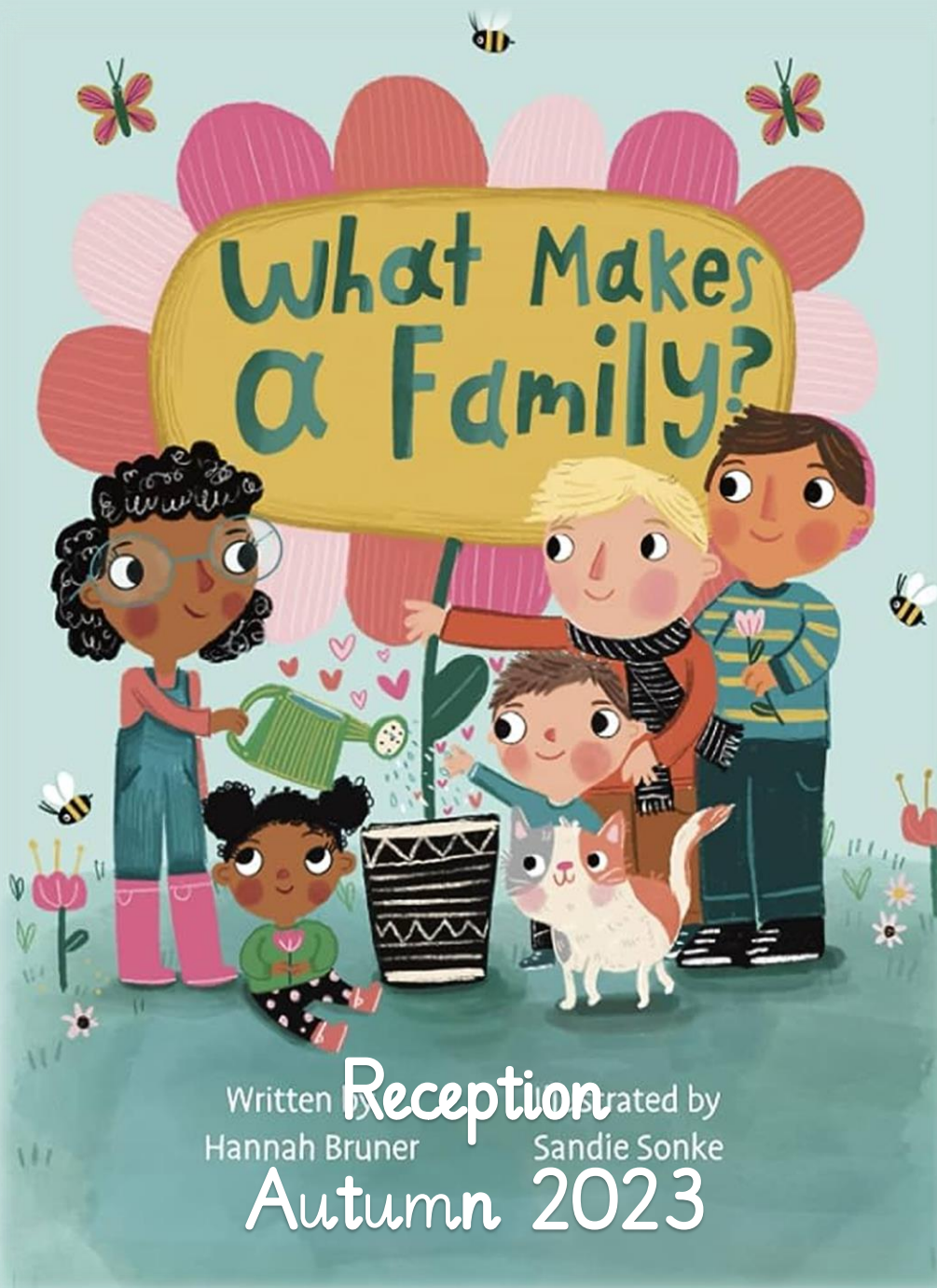
History
