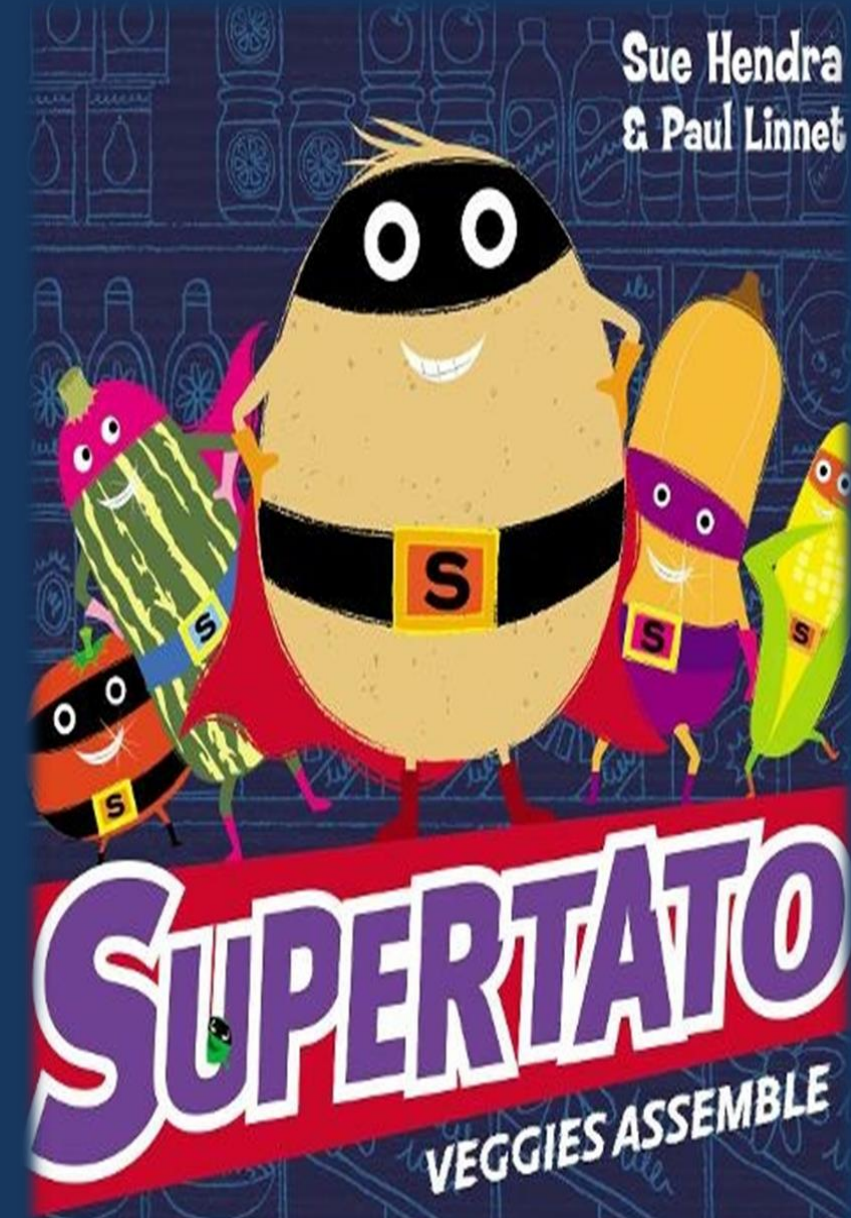


Welcome to The Hive with Mrs Jones, Mrs Britner, Miss Chadwick and Mrs Broad.

Supporting your child at home  
Our Learning Conversation shares daily activities.
