Phonics - Phonics homework will be uploaded on to the Class Dojo portfolio every Monday. This will practice our sounds or words of the week.


Maths - Maths homework will be uploaded on to the Class Dojo portfolio every Monday. This will relate to our maths focus of the week.


PE





