PE

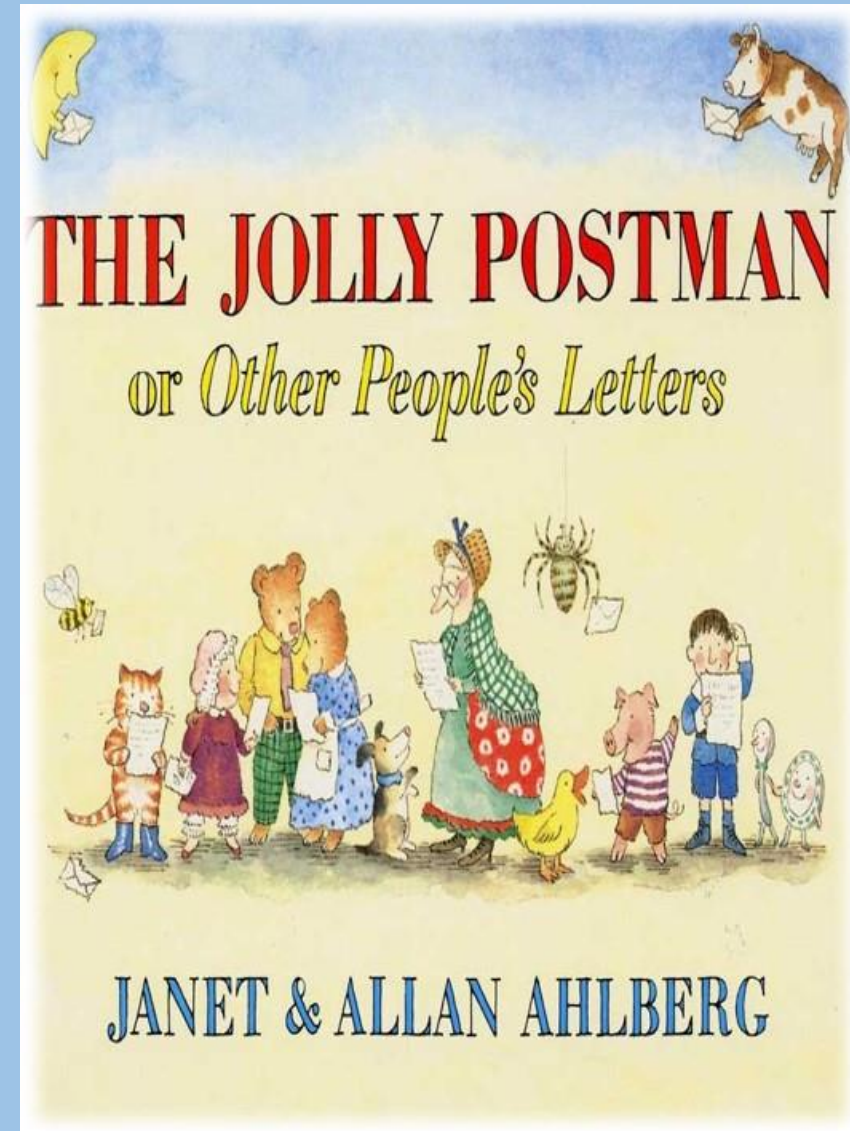
Our class PE day is Tuesday. Please see our Class Dojo story for all PE time slots.

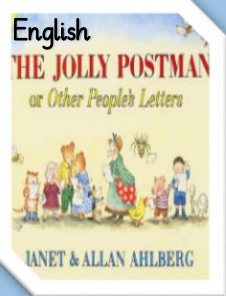
On these days, your child should come to school in their PE kit: a plain white t-shirt, black joggers or leggings and a school jumper or hoody.

Class Dojo and X

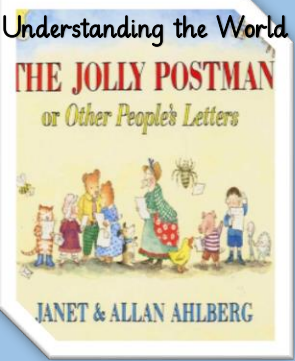
Class Dojo is our method of communication – it is used to share messages with you, Daily Learning Conversations and homework. Any messages during the school day should be sent to the office.

We also use Class Dojo and X to post pictures of your children's learning.

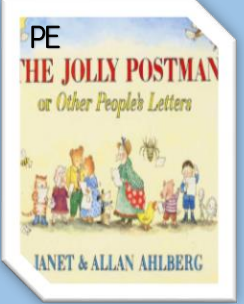




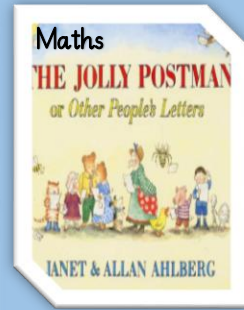
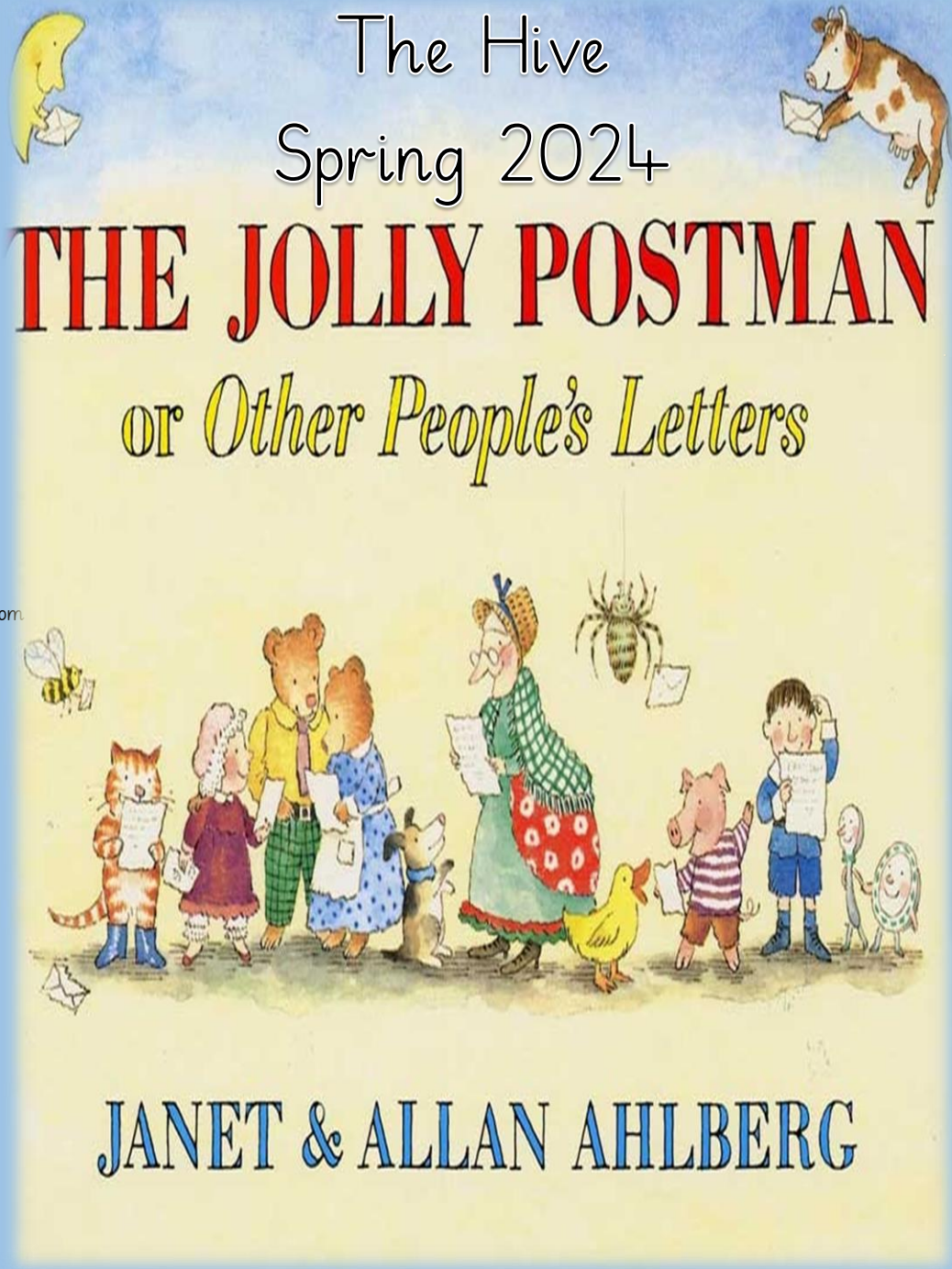
