
Welcome back! I hope you have had a wonderful break, and I am so excited to get to know you all. We have lots of fun learning planned for Spring Term!


We encourage the children to practice their skills 3x per week.

You can message myself or Mrs Anthony via Dojo or Mrs Boyle during the school day.






