PE

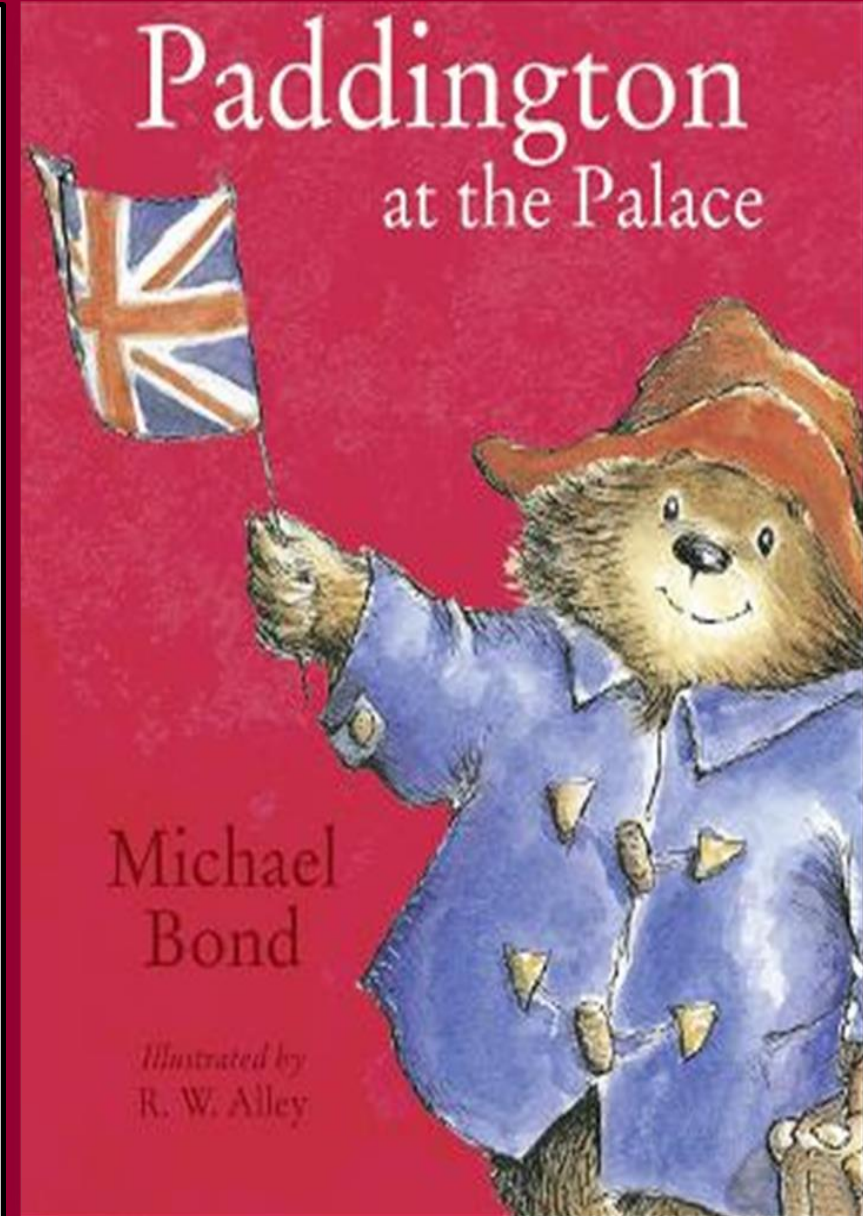
Our PE days are Monday and Wednesday.

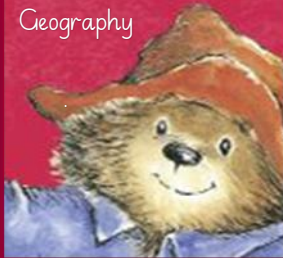


English

Games, gymnastics and dance. Alongside developing our locomotion, stability and teamwork skills.

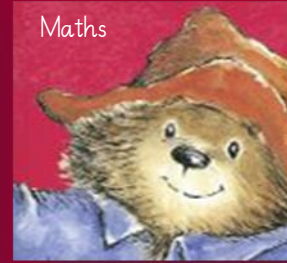
