A weekly maths task will be uploaded to Class Dojo and reinforces learning from the previous week.

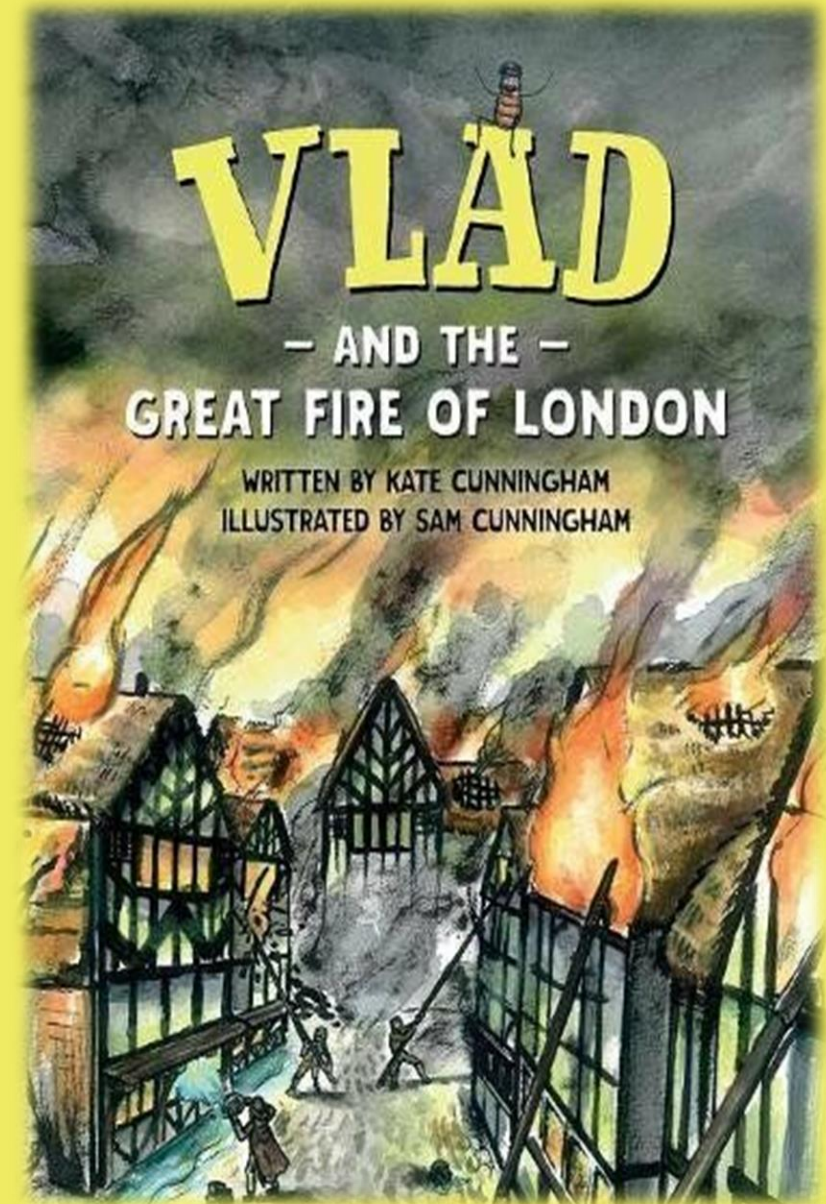
PE

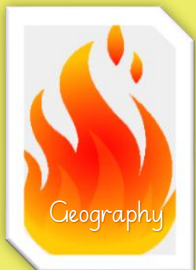

Reading skills, being a character (speech bubbles, diary), continuing the narrative), summary account of the Great Fire of London.

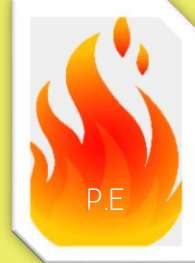
London, St Ives, San Francisco. Location, physical features, human features, human processes and techniques



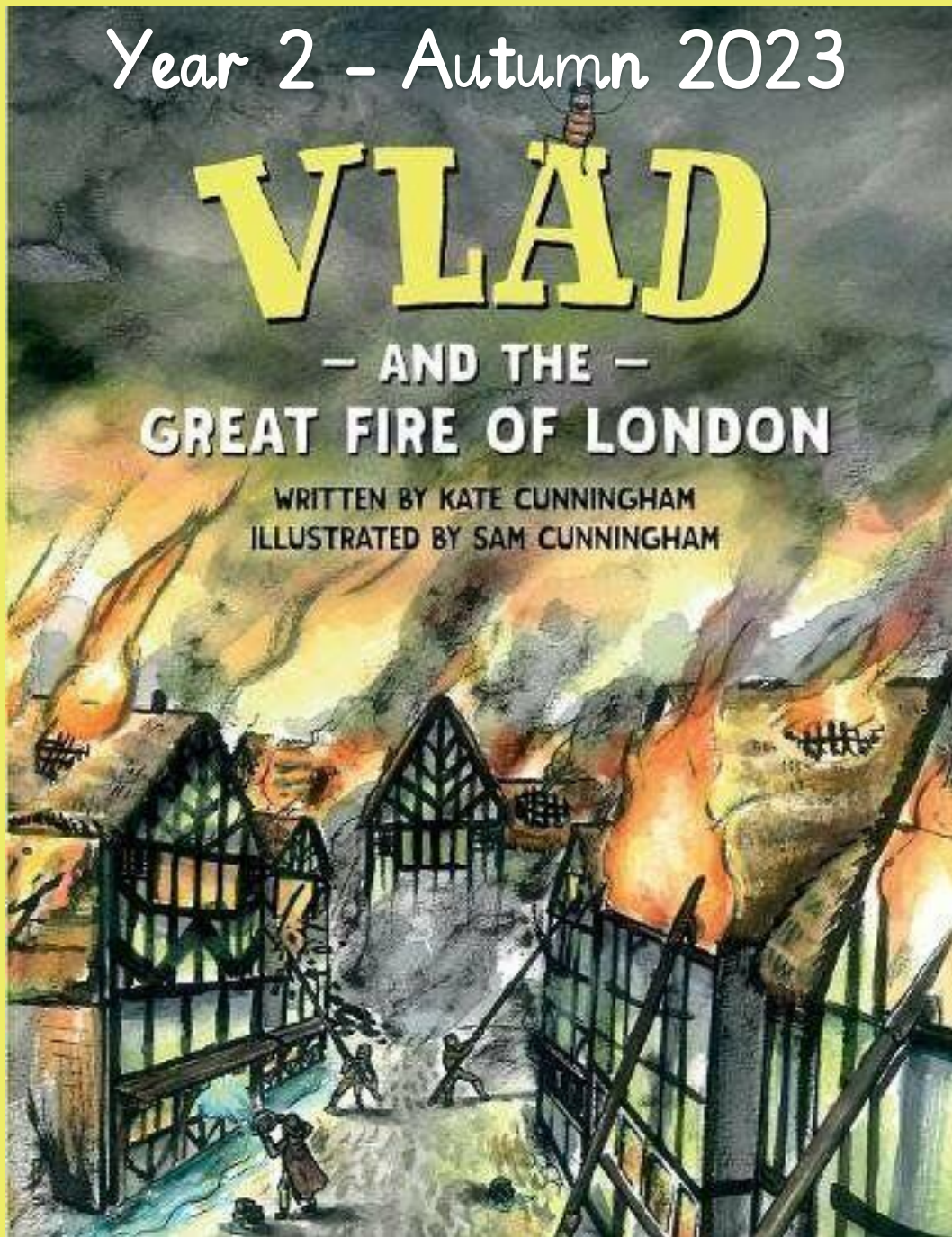

Games – learning to catch and kick a ball. Gymnastics – balancing on one leg and jumping. Dance – Great Fire of London Dance.



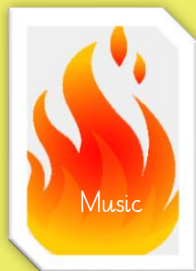
Measurement, place value, shape, addition and subtraction, money, multiplication and division, time, fractions, statistics and position and direction.
