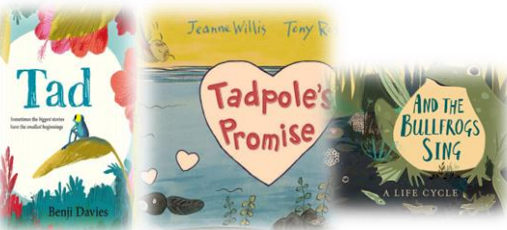

Our homework tasks link to the previous week's learning. They are accessed on a Monday every week and should be completed by Friday.

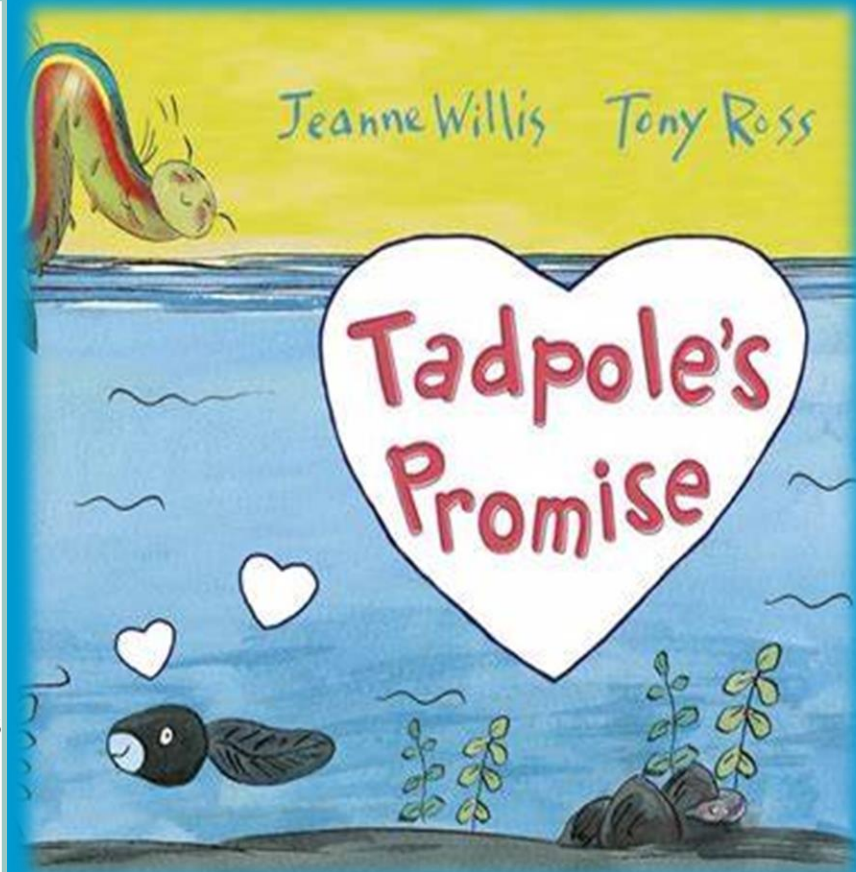
PE
