Our PE days are Monday and Friday.On these days, your child


should come to school in their PE kit: a plain white t-shirt, black joggers or leggings and a school jumper or hoody.

Any messages during the school day should be sent to the office.



The children will exploring different types of settlements, land use, and the difference between urban and rural. Children will describe the different human and physical features in their local area and make land use comparisons with New Delhi.







PE
