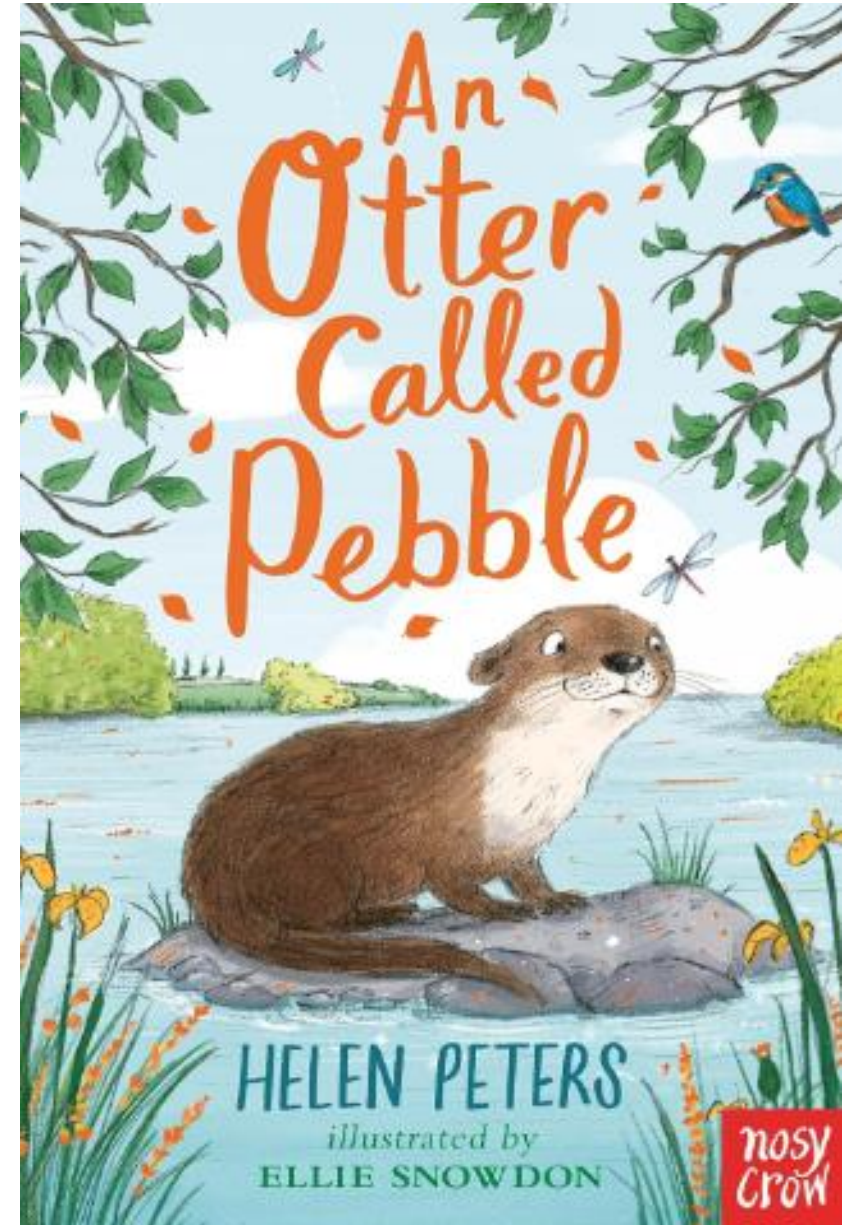
TT Rocks Stars

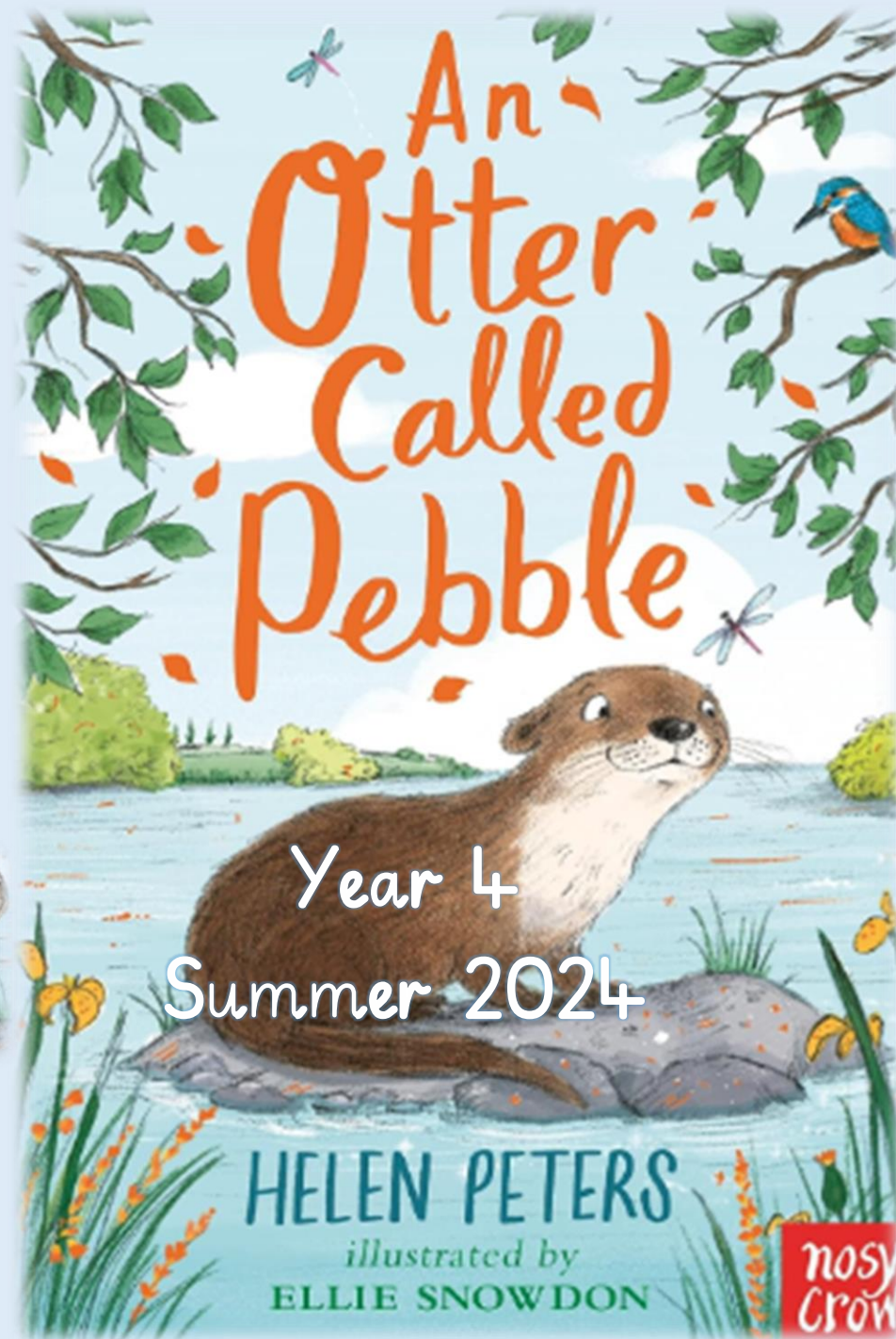
