PE

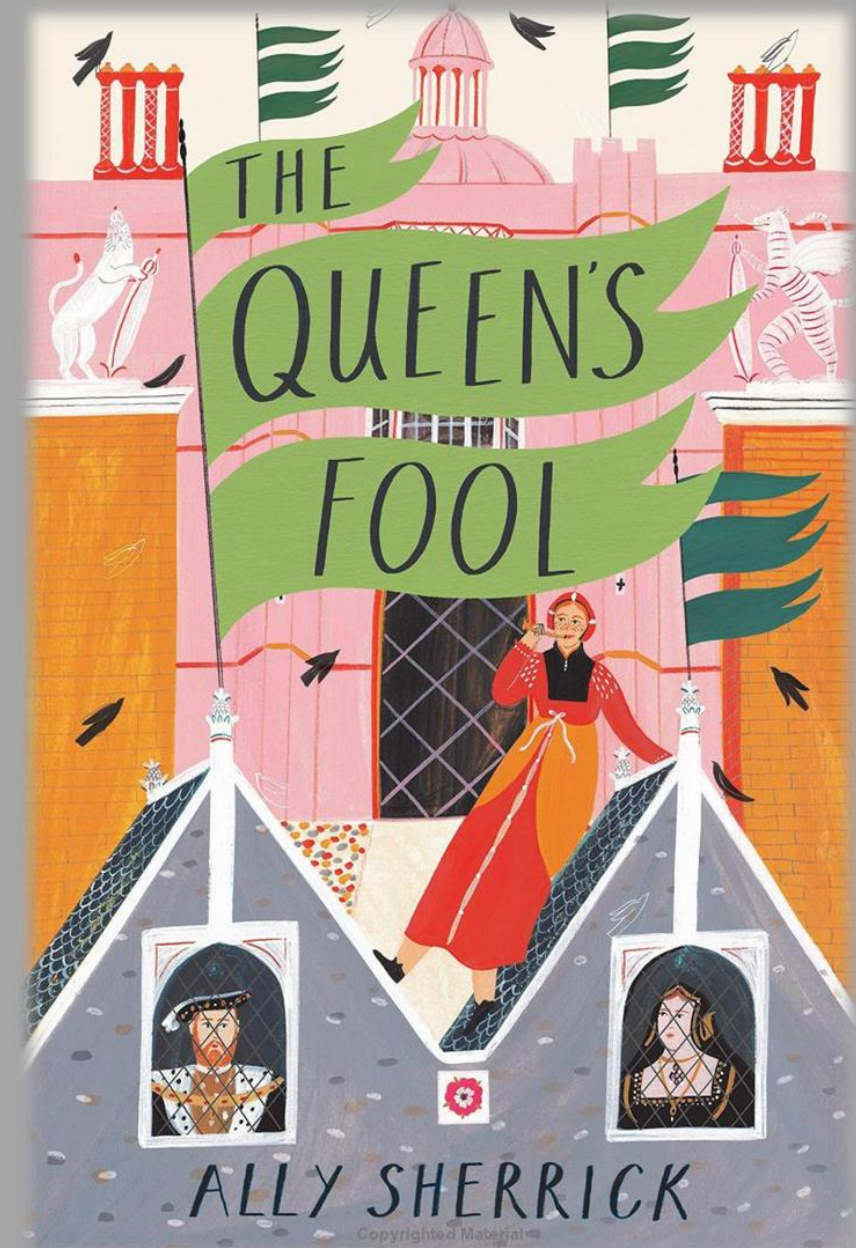
Our PE days are Monday and Wednesday
