PE

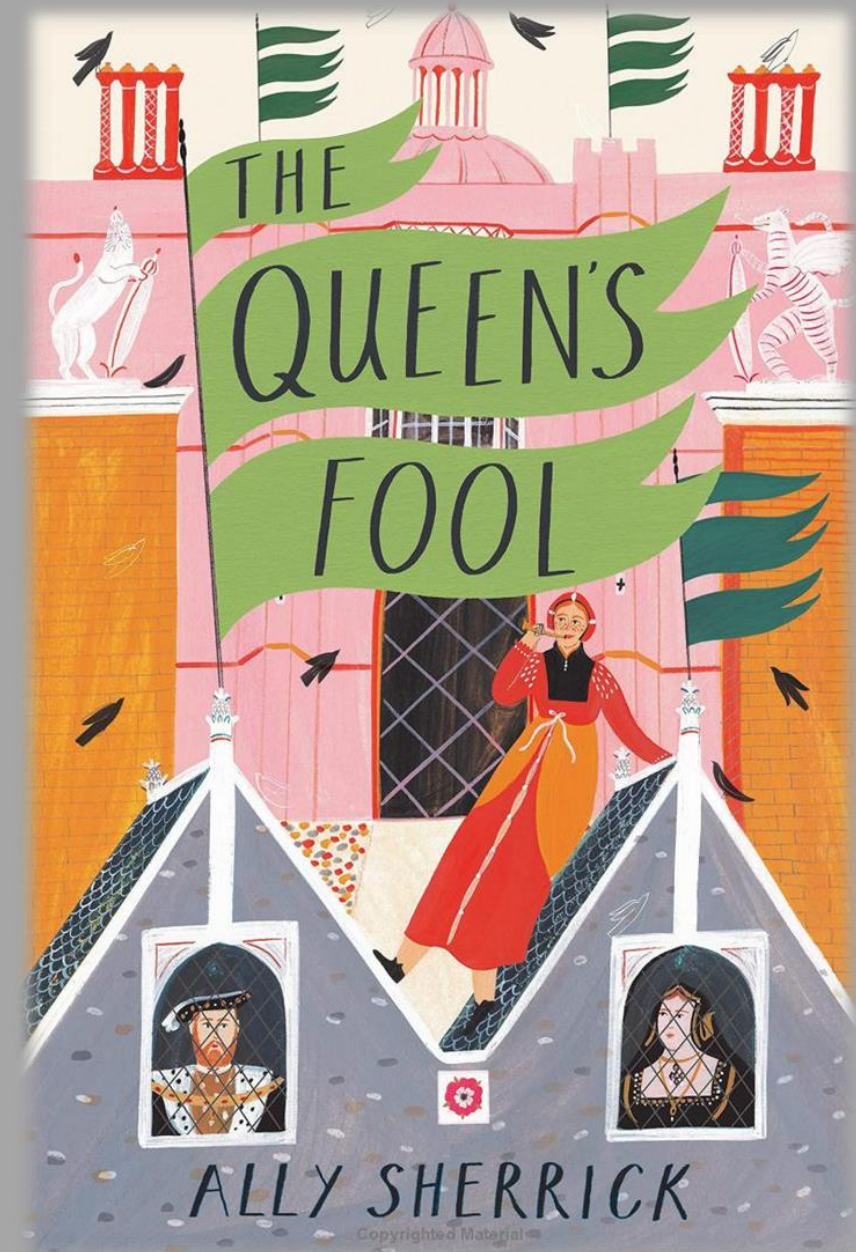
Our PE days are Thursdays and Fridays.

What was life like in Tudor England? We will be investigating the life of Henry VIII and inventories.



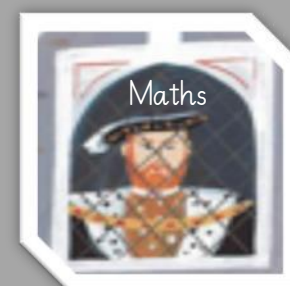
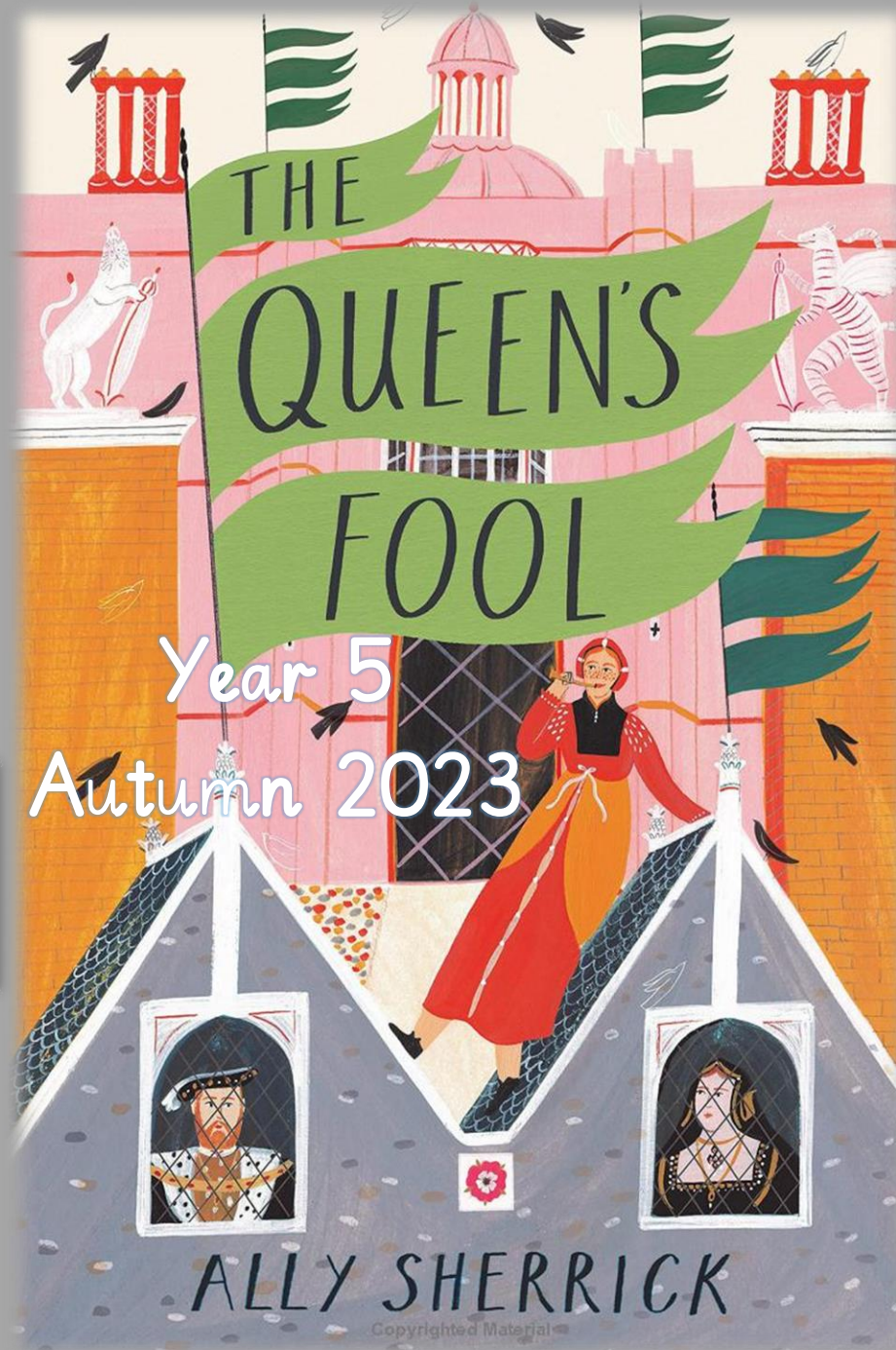
Science
