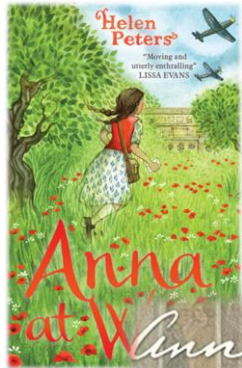


Welcome to Year 6 with Miss Barber and Mrs Garside.

PE

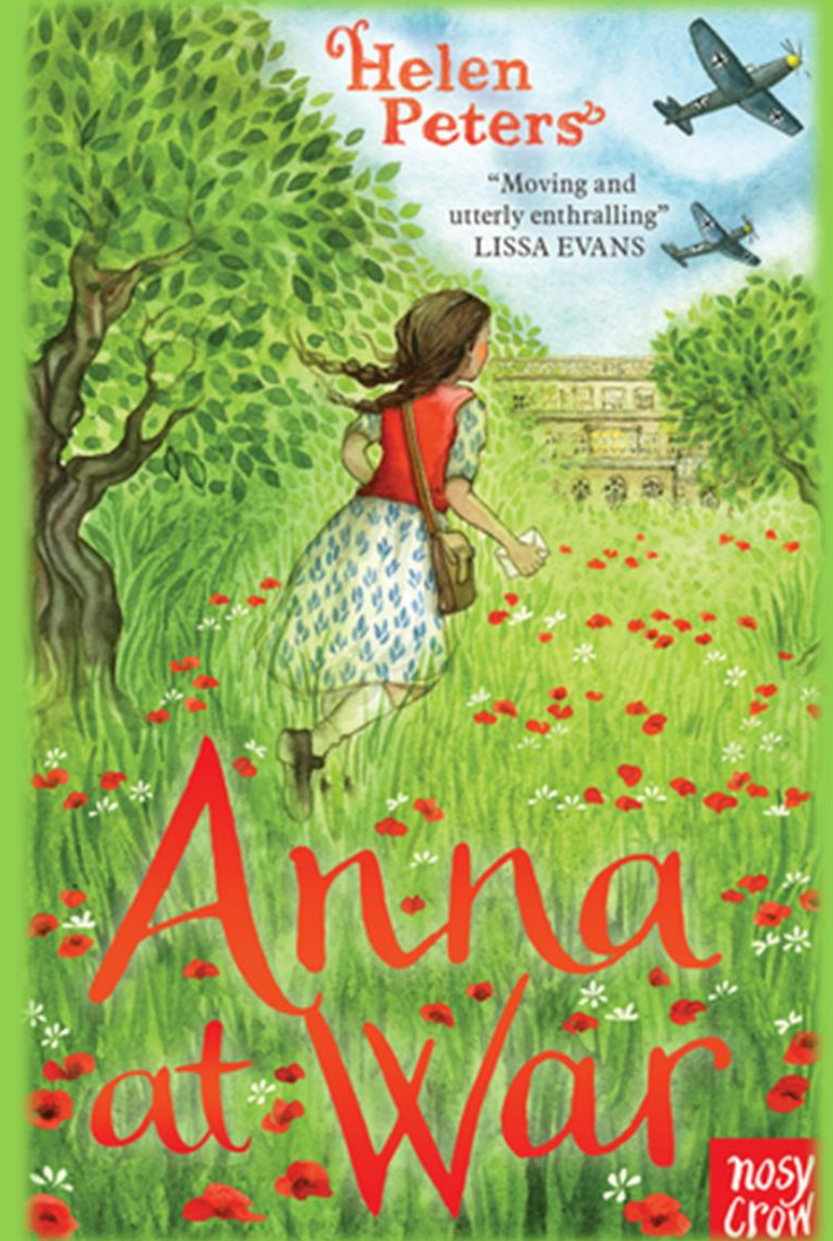
Our PE days are Tuesday (swimming) and Friday (PE in school).

This should be a wonderful term and I am so excited to delve into this new learning!





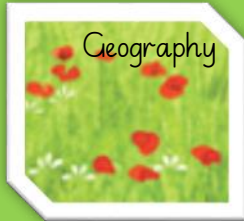
English

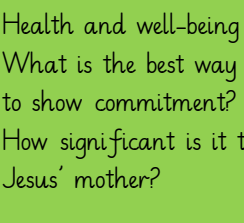
