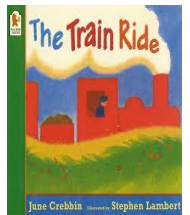
Welcome back!

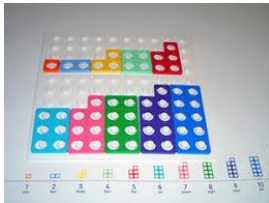
English

Maths
