English

In English we are starting with The Gingerbread Man, where we will create and write our own alternative ending. We will also be learning how to write: a rhyming poem, non-chronological report, a formal letter and a re-count (based on an exciting trip we have coming up!) We have some great books for Year 1 to enjoy which they will base their writing on.







Maths

This term in Maths our units are: Capacity, multiplication and division, fractions, geometry (position and direction), place value (within 100), money and time. Every Tuesday, Mathletics homework is set, linked to our topic in class; you can find your child's login details in their planner. www.mathletics.co.uk

Topic

Our topic this term is 'Fly High, Touch The Sky'. We will be researching and learning about The Wright Brothers and the first flight. We will be visiting Manchester Airport. In Science, we will be learning about materials, investigating and conducting experiments! In Art, we will be making our own clay sculptures. In Geography, we will be naming and locating the 4 countries of the UK, Capitals and surrounding seas. In Computing, we are sorting data and creating pictographs.
