First of all, I would like to welcome you and your child to life in Year 5. I am very excited to working with all of you and to having a really fun and successful year.

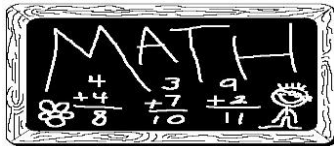
The class have already settled in really well to the year and have made a really productive start to the year.

English

Our English genres this term will be Narrative viewpoint (one character), Narrative, character portrait, report writing, explanation texts and study of a significant poet. We will learn all our grammar and punctuation within our English lessons.



Maths

Among the many subjects we will be studying in Maths are: Numbers to 10,000, Roman Numerals to 1,000, Rounding to the nearest 10, 100, 1000, comparing and ordering numbers to 100, 000, counting in 10s, 100s, 1000s, 10,000s and 100,000s and negative numbers.

Topic

Our topic is called "The Art of Survival". Our Science work will be looking at Animals including humans, Evolution and inheritance. Our Geography work will look at mapwork including 4 and 6 figure grid references. Our History is looking at Changes in Britain from the Stone Age to the Iron age.

We will also be studying other subjects outside the topic.
