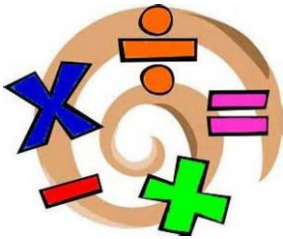
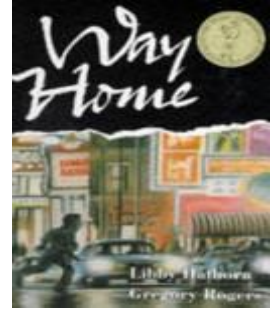


Welcome back!
