

Year 6 Newsletter Summer 2018

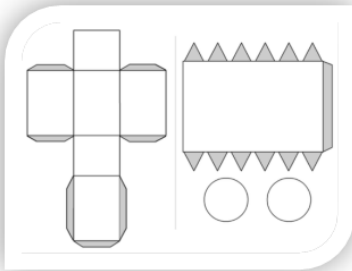


Welcome back!
