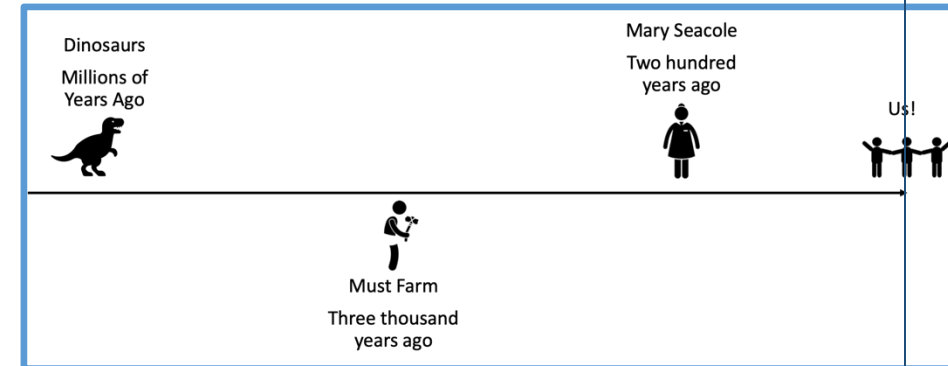

Pre-history	The time before people wrote things down.	
Archaeologist	A person who looks in the ground for clues about the past.	
Artefact	Something people made a long time ago.	



Knowledge Organiser- Kings, Queens and Leaders (History Year One)



Key Vocabulary	Definition
Throne	A special chair for a king or queen, or another very important person
Sceptre	An ornamented (decorated) rod carried by rulers on special occasions
Majesty	A royal person
Reign	The time/ period that a person is in charge and rules over the country
Barons	An important person who owns land
The Magna Carta	A written promise (charter) that was sealed by King John
Civil war	A war between people who live in the same country
Coronation	When a king or queen is given the crown



Queen Elizabeth II



King John sealed the Magna Carta in 1216.



Henry III was captured by Simon de Montfort who set up a parliament.



Charles I was executed in 1649.



Oliver Cromwell was the Lord Protector.



Charles II returned from hiding in France to be King of England in 1660.
